### EVENT SCHEDULE

## **GENERAL INFO**

Thank you for looking into playing at the GT! I am very excited to be able to bring Batman to this event and I look forward to creating an experience that is fun for everyone!

### **PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES**

Players are responsible for bringing the following:

- Miniatures that are used in their crew lists
- Objective Cards to form their Objective Decks
- 2 Sewer Markers and 2 Lamp Post Markers
- 3 Deployment and 3 Event cards
- Measuring Devices, Widgets, Tokens, etc.
- 2 printed copies of your Crew Roster
  - 1 for your Opponent each round
  - 1 for the Tournament Organizer

Players must bring two copies of their list for each event they participate in. They may be in any format, but must clearly spell out the whole list, equipment, rep costs, funding costs, and objective cards.

### **SPORTSMANSHIP AND RULINGS**

I will strive to create a fun and welcoming environment. Players should do their best to be respectful towards each other, as we're all here to have a good time.

If a rules question arises during a game, call on the Judge. If there is no resolution to be found, they will make an on-the-spot call that will be final in order to keep the game going. After the conclusion of a game, it is permissible to clarify or discuss the decision further.

### **EVENT REGISTRATION**

The Michigan GT is hosting two Batman Miniature Game (BMG) tournaments. Registration for those tournaments can be found at [michiganqt.com](http://michiganqt.com). As this is the first year BMG has been at the GT, participation for both of these are capped at 8 players.

However, there is a waitlist if you happen to miss out on one of the spots. Based on the players on the waitlist, more space at the tournament will be allocated and more spots opened. If there is interest, the GT organizers have assured me that players will be able to play.

Registering as soon as possible also allows the Tournament Organizer (TO) time to plan out and create enough terrain tables for use at the GT. Early interest would be appreciated but it is completely up to you the player.

## **LIST SUBMISSION AND DEADLINES**

The Skirmish and No Man's Land events will use the Modified Standard format discussed later.

Players can submit their lists either:

- Lists can be submitted via the Michigan GT Skirmish and Michigan GT No Man's Land events on GameUplink by **Friday, September 22nd at 10pm EST**.

GameUplink will allow lists to be submitted using a list builder via a URL link.

The greatest BMG list builder can be found at <https://bmg.azurewebsites.net/>. After creating a simple account, the website allows free unlimited list creation and inventory tracking. The content creator has put a lot of time and effort into this wonderful website and I would encourage donations as it is a fan project.

After creating a list, copy the URL for the list and submit into the List section of the GameUplink site.

If players wish to have physical cards for use during their games, it is imperative to submit by the 22nd to allow the TO time to acquire cards.

## **TABLE FACINGS**

Table facings will not be fixed for this event. The player who chooses their deployment zone first is free to set up however they like and their opponent will take the other.

# **LIST BUILDING**

## **MODIFIED STANDARD FORMAT**

In an effort to give players access to the widest amount of miniatures available, the Modified Standard format was created by the Renegade Open. This format allows for any model released in BMG's 2nd edition Resin or in 3rd edition is allowed, with the caveat that any model banned under the BATMAN MINIATURE GAME UPDATE document remains banned. In addition, any model that was moved to DCUMG only via the original 3rd edition announcement remains excluded from the BMG.

## **CONVERSIONS & PROXIES**

Players are encouraged to convert their models. The model must be clearly recognizable and must be declared by its owner prior to the start of the game to avoid confusion. Proxies are not allowed; you must use the correct model with its corresponding card.

You are allowed to use a converted 1st or 2nd edition model to represent a resin 3rd edition model. Creativity is encouraged!

If you're in doubt whether your model is a conversion or a proxy, please contact the TO prior to the event and he will make a ruling.

## **STAT, OBJECTIVE, DEPLOYMENT AND EVENT CARDS**

### **STAT CARDS**

Players must always use the latest version of a model's card. Players are allowed to make their own cards but must submit them to the TO for approval during registration for the event in which the cards will be used. Players are allowed to use tournament cards (also called foil cards) without owning the specific card. If you use a substitute card (homemade or photocopied, for example) please submit this to the TO for approval during registration.

The stat card in the official app takes precedence. If a model's card is different from its card on the app, players must use the stats, traits, etc. found on the app.

The TOs understand that there are certain issues in this long transitional stage from physical to digital cards. If you have issues accessing the app or need help knowing exactly what the stats are, please let the TO know a few days prior to the first event. He will send you screenshots for your reference.

We strive to use the most updated, balanced, fun rules for each model. There are very few changes between a model's PDF card on [www.knightmodels.com](http://www.knightmodels.com) and its digital card on the app, so this should only affect a handful of models.

### OBJECTIVE CARDS

Players are highly encouraged to use the latest version of the objective cards. These can be found in Objective Set 1, Objective Set 2 as well as The Batman starter set (in the case of Batman and Organized Crime cards), as well as in both the KM app and the Azure builder. If a player uses cards printed prior to these releases, bear in mind that you will need to use the most up-to-date versions for play.

Objective Card Decks for this event will be a **20 CARD** with **SIDEBOARD**.

### **20 CARD**

Players will bring a 20 card Objective Deck as per the Batman Miniature Game rules. These decks may also include up to 3 Character cards of named characters that they have in their crew lists. If players have multiple lists, the Objective deck must be the same for both lists; however, only the character cards for characters that appear in the list used for the game may be added to the Objective Deck.

### **SIDEBOARD**

In addition, players may bring a **sideboard** of 6 objective cards. All 26 Objective Deck cards must follow the normal deck building rules (You must take all copies of a card, etc.). List the 6 sideboard cards below your standard 20 card deck list.

In the pre-game steps, when players share their rosters and deck lists with their opponents, after players determine which of their two lists they wish to play for the game, they may now switch out cards from their deck with cards from their sideboard. After the switches have been made, the deck must be fully legal as per the core rules.

After the game, the objective decks are reset to their original 20 card list and 6 card sideboard.

### DEPLOYMENT AND EVENT CARDS

For each event, players must choose 3 Deployment and 3 Event cards and list them on their roster sheet.

Order proceeds as follows:

- Player A rolls a 6 for pre-game initiative, and Player B rolls a 1.
  - Player A has pre-game initiative.
- Player B then puts out their 3 Deployment Cards. Player A chooses to discard 1, and player B chooses which 1 of the remaining 2 to use for the game.
- Player A puts out their 3 Event cards. Player B chooses to discard 1, and Player A chooses which 1 of the remaining 2 to use for the game.

### SLEEVES

Players must use sleeves with opaque (non-transparent) backs for their objective cards. They must all be the same color. Opaque sleeves are optional for all other cards.
